



The garage is located at a bus depot at Brubakkveien 16. It is a 400 m. Walk from Grorud train station. Grorud station is operated by Line 1 (L1) from Oslo.

Guidelines for visitors to Ruter and Holo self-driving facilities

These guidelines are intended to provide information and guidance to external visitors. They aim to ensure the safety and security of all visitors and staff, and to maintain the smooth operation of the bus depot and self-driving garage facilities.

General Guidelines

- When arriving at the gate, proceed directly to the Holo/Ruter entrance and contact your appointed host for your visit.
- Visitors must exercise caution and common sense when navigating the depot premises. Be aware of moving vehicles, machinery, and other potential hazards.
- Access to certain areas of the depot may be restricted to authorized personnel only. Visitors must adhere to all signage and instructions regarding restricted areas.
- Visitors are prohibited from engaging in any activities that could disrupt the operation of the depot or endanger the safety of themselves or others. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Interfering with bus operations or personnel
 - Entering restricted areas without authorization
 - Being influenced by alcohol or drugs
- Photo or video filming is prohibited.
 - Exterior of the vehicle in the “visitors corner” is available for photo/filming, please ask your host for guidelines.
 - **The LiDARs on the vehicles can damage mobile phone cameras!**
Remember to ask if they are turned off before taking photos.
